COVID-19 POLICY AND DECLARATION FORM

Effective June 13, 2022 the Italian Cultural Center (ICC) requires:

- Proof of vaccination or a negative test within 72 hours and optional masking for all **Language Classes and Cultural Events**; ICC will also conform to the requirements of its partners/places where certain events will be held this Summer.

The vaccination card must show a regimen completed at least 14 days prior to the date of the class or event that the participant plans to attend. Proof of vaccination or negative test will have to be provided upon entry to the class or event.

These measures are implemented to improve the safety for all, but they are not absolute protection against COVID-19. Guests assume their own risk by entering the ICC premises. The measures currently in place are subject to change and may be revised any time.

Stay home if you are not feeling well, or have exhibited symptoms of COVID-19.
