



COVID 19 POLICY UPDATE – 3/21/2022

While public health guidelines relax, The Italian Cultural Center (ICC) requires, effective March 21st, 2022:

- Proof of vaccination or a negative test within 72 hours and masking for all **Adult Language School Spring Term classes**
- Proof of vaccination or a negative test within 72 hours and optional masking for all **Cultural Events**; ICC will also conform to the requirements of its partners/places where certain events will be held this Spring.

When registering for classes or events, check for updates in the related descriptions.

The vaccination card must show a regimen completed at least 14 days prior to the date of the class or event that the participant plans to attend. Proof of vaccination or negative test will have to be provided upon entry to the class or event.

These measures are implemented to improve the safety for all, but they are not absolute protection against COVID-19. Guests assume their own risk by entering the ICC premises. The measures currently in place are subject to change and may be revised any time.

Stay home if you are not feeling well, or have exhibited symptoms of COVID-19. Refer to MDH quarantine guidance (<https://www.health.state.mn.us/diseases/coronavirus/close.html>) regarding when to stay home after a potential COVID 19 exposure. If you tested positive or have symptoms of COVID-19, stay home until your health care provider tells you it is safe to stop isolating.

The COVID-19 policy also applies to the ICC administrative staff, instructors and Board members.
